- \*Water footprint: Total volume of water needed to produce a product or service

- Organize actions according to the «4 R» sequence: Reduce, Recycle, Recover, and Reuse, to ensure sustainable water resource management.
- Use all types of proven or innovative technologies to measure and improve the management of facilities that impact our water footprint.

Control of Discharges
Limiting the disturbance of the natural water cycle, by contributing to the return of used water to nature at a quality level aimed at achieving good ecological status of the environment.

#### **Communication**

- Encourage suppliers and customers to adopt efficient and rational water resource management practices.
- \* Implement or support stakeholder communication initiatives (both internal and external) to promote efficient and rational water resource management.
