01

02

An environmental analysis of the Group's activities, highlighting ecological risks, is carried out periodically.

03

Commit to using the **Best Available Technology (BAT)**, particularly by employing existing good practices applicable to our activities.

04

Define and consider the **environmental impacts** of its investments.

05

Implement, where possible, waste management based on the «4Rs» sequence: **Reduce, Reuse, Recycle, Repair.**

Limit the impact on natural resources across all our activities.

07

Evaluate and limit the pollution and disturbances generated by our activities, products, and services.

08

Prevent and minimize the consequences of industrial risks associated with our facilities.

09

Commit to considering and **respecting biodiversity**, both at our sites and at our suppliers.

10

Commit to raising **awareness** among clients and suppliers towards managing their activities' **environmental impacts**, maintaining a transparent and constructive attitude towards **all stakeholders** (including authorities).
